EXPERIENCE LEVEL

Advanced Beginner

MATERIALS

- Blue Sky Skinny Dyed Cotton: 1 hank MC, 1 hank CC1, 1 hank CC2
 - Size 6 (4mm) 12" circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge
 - Size 6 (4mm) set of double pointed needles, or size needed to obtain gauge
 - Stitch marker
 - Tapestry needle
- Photo Shown: Boy–French Blue #316, Glacier #301, Gravel #314; Girl–Cherry #309, Coffee #310, Coral #317

SIZES

Instructions are given for the smallest size, with larger sizes in parentheses. When one number is given, it applies to all sizes. Toddler (child, woman, man) to fit approx 16 (18, 20, 22)" head circumference.

GAUGE

In (p3, k2) rib, 22 sts and 34 rows = 4" when blocked (row gauge not crucial)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width (when laying flat): 7½ (8½, 9½, 10½)" across
Length: 6½ (7, 7½, 8)"

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Beg: Beginning
CC: Contrasting color
CO: Cast on
K: Knit
K2tog: Knit 2 sts together
MC: Main color
P: Purl
P2Tog: Purl 2 sts together
Rep: Repeat
Rnd: Round
St: Stitch

PATTERN NOTES

Rib Pattern Stitch: *P3, k2, rep from * around.

Stripe Sequence

7 rnds MC
1 rnd CC1
2 nds CC2
1 rnd CC1

HAT

With circular ndl and MC, CO 85 (95, 105, 115) sts, pm and join in rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work in Rib Pattern Stitch and Stripe Sequence for 5½ (6, 6½, 7)", being sure to stretch ribbing to lay flat (finished measurements width) when measuring length. Switch to dpns when necessary when working decrease rounds.

Next Rnd (dec): *P1, p2tog, k2, rep from * around. [68 (76, 84, 92) sts]

Next Rnd: *P2, k2, rep from * around.

Next Rnd (dec): *P2, k2tog, rep from * around. [51 (57, 63, 69) sts]

Next Rnd: *P2, k1, rep from * around.

Next Rnd (dec): *P2tog, k1, rep from * around. [34 (38, 42, 46) sts]

Next Rnd: *P1, k1, rep from * around.

Next Rnd (dec): *K2tog, rep from * to last st, remove marker, k2tog (knit rem st along with the 1 st of next rnd). PM for new beg of rnd. [17 (19, 21, 23) sts]

Next Rnd (dec): *K2tog, rep from * to last st, k1. [9 (10, 11, 12) sts]

FINISHING

Break yarn leaving 10". Using tapestry needle, thread through rem sts twice, pull snug and secure. Weave in loose ends. 🐿
